

## *Enrolling with The Australian College of Theology (ACT)*

1. Complete the 'Enrolment in ACT Units' form. (There is one form for both continuing students and new students.)

- (a) List all subjects being studied for credit in the **current** semester, irrespective of the locations at which you study. Students doing monthly subjects are to enrol them in Semester 1.

Refer to the table on the back of this sheet for the official ACT subject names and subject codes. You will need to list the ACT subject titles on the form.

Note that on the form 'units' is just what the ACT calls subjects.

- (b) Fill out your personal details. Provide your ACT number. If you are a new student, leave this line blank because you will be given a number by the ACT after you enrol for the first time.

- (c) The college is Mary Andrews College or you may write 'MAC' for short.

- (d) Sign and date the declaration at the bottom of the second side of the enrolment form.

2. ACT enrolments fees are incorporated into the subject fee. There is no need to pay any additional fee.

3. Give your enrolment form to your lecturer, who will hand it onto the Registrar.

4. Enrolment forms will be signed by the Registrar once they have been handed in. The information is then processed with the ACT.

5. Your enrolment form must be received by the Registrar by the Administration Date for your subject, otherwise you will be charged a Variation of Enrolment fee.

If you have any further questions about filling out this form, please feel free to ask your lecturer or the Registrar (making sure that you still get your form in to the Registrar by the due date).
