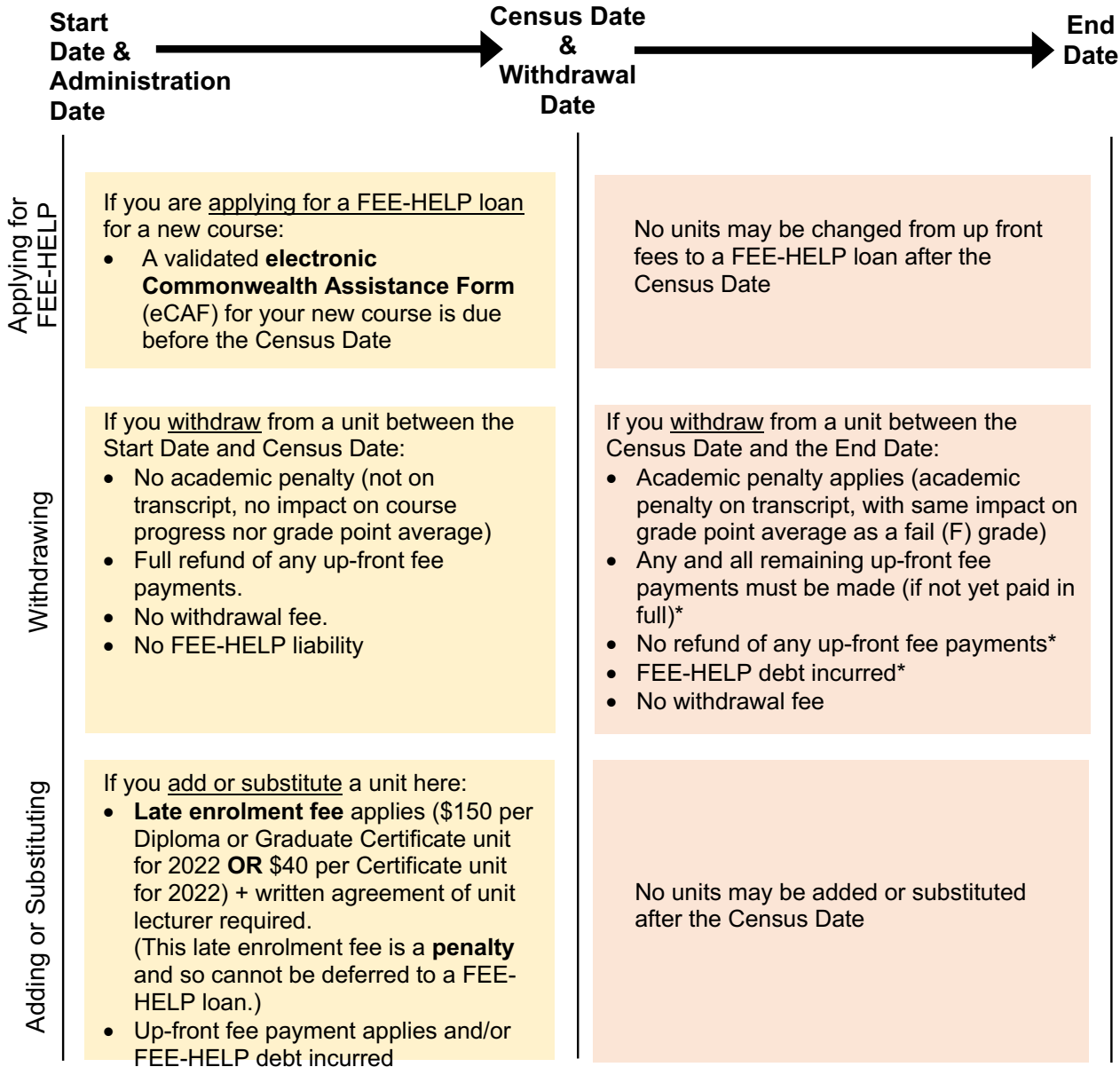

*** Special circumstances for withdrawals:**

Students who withdraw from a unit of study due to circumstances outside of their control which occur, worsen or do not make their impact known until or after the Census Date may be eligible for a Tuition Fee Refund.

If a Tuition Fee Refund is granted, students will also receive the grade Compassionate Withdrawal (CW) for that unit, which has no academic penalty.

Any up-front tuition fees already paid will be refunded (to the payer) and the student's FEE-HELP debt for that unit will be removed.
